CHILD BENEFIT

You can get [Child Benefit](#) if you are responsible for bringing up a child who is:

- under 16
- under 20 if they stay in approved [education or training](#)

Only one person can get Child Benefit for a child. It is paid every 4 weeks and there is no limit to how many children you can claim for.

SCOTTISH WELFARE FUND COMMUNITY CARE GRANT

A [Community Care Grant](#) can be given, if you qualify, to help with costs if:

- you are leaving care or imprisonment and need help to start a settled home
- you have been homeless, or living an unsettled life, and need help to start a settled home
- you need support to stay out of care
- you are caring for someone who has been release from prison or a young offender's institution
- you are experiencing great pressure and need help to keep a settled home
- you are escaping domestic abuse
- a child's health is at risk
