Did you know we have an online portal called My Home? This can be accessed by any owners who receive services from us.

The portal enables you to access information securely and undertake various functions such as: -

LEGIONELLA CHECKS

Is your property going to be vacant for a period of a week or more? If it is, we strongly recommend on your return you flush the water system.

This involves running all taps and showers for a minimum of two minutes, plus flushing all the toilets. It is also recommended that you regularly clean and descale your shower head.

Do you rent out your property?

If you rent out your property there are a few vital pieces of information that would help us carry out the communal factoring as efficiently as possible.

In case of emergencies, we may need contact details anyone who manages the property, or the tenants who reside in the property.

To update any details please email factoring@ochilviewha.co.uk to keep us up to date.

If we do not have this, it can delay any emergency repairs required and makes it more difficult for us to contact the correct person for any correspondence.

Keep Communal Closes Clear

The common stair is your only means of escape in the event of a fire.

Have you ever thought what vou would do if a fire were to break out in your stair? It may not necessarily be in your property. A fire started in a



common stair could be fatal. Even a small bag of rubbish can create enough smoke to fill a whole stair.

Items left in a common stair are often deliberately set on fire.

KEEP IT CLEAR

- · Get rubbish, old furniture etc out of the building
- Make sure storage areas are kept locked
- · For advice on uplifting items contact your local council

Landscaping UPDATE

We are now in our Spring/ Summer phase of landscaping within our developments. You should have now noticed that the Landscape contractors have been starting to prepare our communal gardens for the summer months. SUMMER MONTHS (APRIL TO OCTOBER)

- Grass Cutting Every 10 working days, except in very inclement weather conditions.
- Grass Edging Every 10 working days plus annual edge reforming (not including naturalised areas).
- Shrub Pruning Once or twice per year, depending on species.
- Weed Control As required.
- Hedge Trimming 2 times per year
- Litter Picking Every 10 working days
